



Recreational Fire Rules For the City of Airway Heights



The following list of requirements is compiled from the International Fire Codes (IFC) and Department of Natural Resources. This list outlines the restrictions that are in place for recreational fires in the City of Airway Heights.

- 1) Fires must be 25 feet away from any structure or combustible material.
- 2) Conditions which could cause a fire to spread within 25 feet of a structure shall be eliminated prior to ignition.
- 3) Recreational fires must not be more than 3 feet in diameter and 2 feet in height.
- 4) Recreational fires must have some means of being immediately extinguished.
- 5) Recreational fires must not be offensive because of smoke emissions.
- 6) Recreational fires are prohibited when hazardous fire conditions exist in the region.
- 7) Recreational fires must be attended until the fire is fully extinguished.
- 8) Recreational fires fueled by wood must be dry, clean and natural (untreated) or manufactured logs. The fire cannot be used to dispose of anything, including paper, natural vegetation, garbage, etc.

Please be sure that you meet these provisions for all recreational fires within the city limits of Airway Heights.
