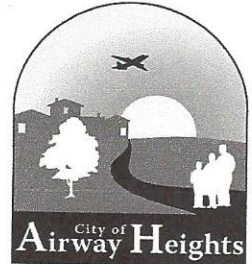





CITIZENS COMMENTS
